Recurrence is unusual when dealt with by a seasoned dermatologist. Complete excision or correct laser ablation usually gets rid of the sore entirely.

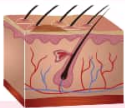
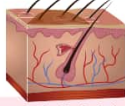
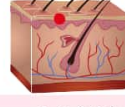
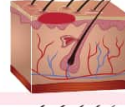
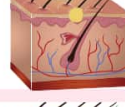
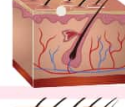
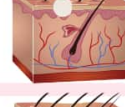
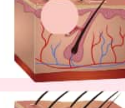
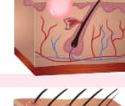
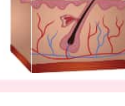
