Why car key replacement needs more than a blank key

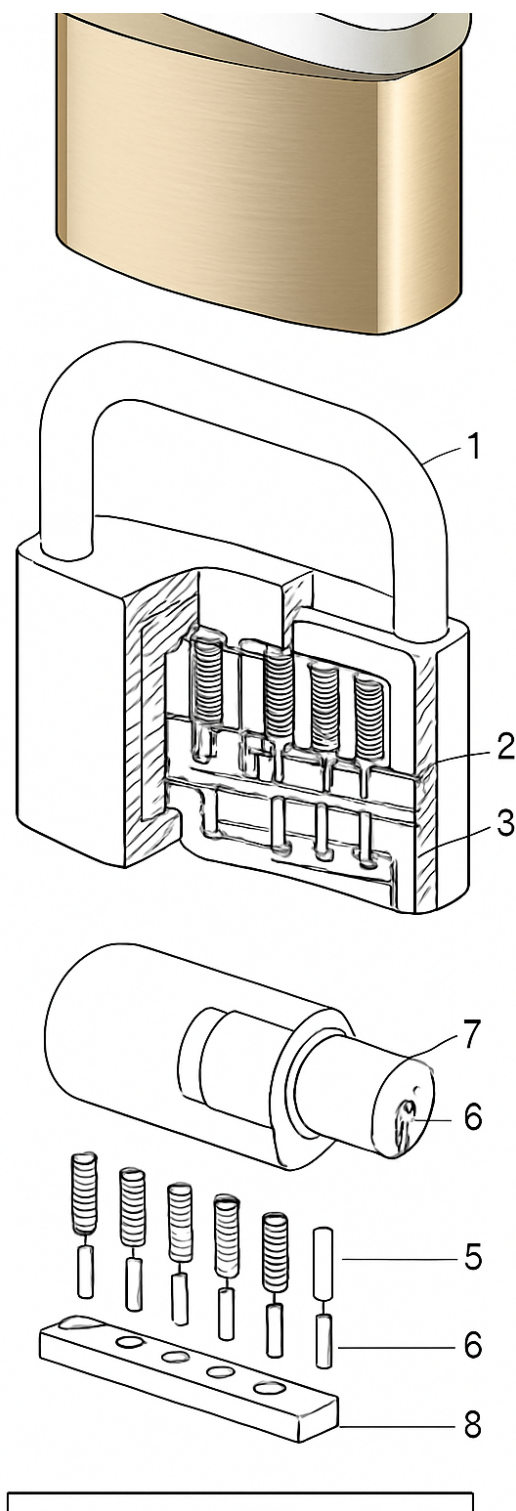
