The focal point of the video game is a huge, vertically installed wheel including 54 segments. Players position bets on where they think the wheel will stop after a spin. Understanding the Wheel Segments and Bets

To play Crazy Time efficiently, gamers should first comprehend the wagering layout. The 54 sectors on the wheel are divided into number bets and perk video game bets. Each segment provides different payout potentials and probabilities.

Number Bets

- **1:** Appears 21 times on the wheel. Payout: 1:1
- **2:** Appears 13 times on the wheel. Payment: 2:1
- **5:** Appears 7 times on the wheel. Payout: 5:1
- **10:** Appears 4 times on the wheel. Payout: 10:1

Benefit Game Bets

- **Coin Flip:** Appears 4 times on the wheel.

- **Cash Hunt:** Appears 2 times on the wheel.
- **Pachinko:** Appears 2 times on the wheel.
- **Crazy Time:** Appears 1 time on the wheel.

The Top Slot Feature

Before every single spin of the primary wheel, a tiny two-reel fruit machine situated above the primary wheel spins concurrently.

- **How it Works:** The left reel shows among the wagering alternatives (numbers or perk video games), while the right reel shows a multiplier (varying from 2x as much as 50x).
- **The Result:** If the sign on the left reel matches the outcome of the primary wheel spin, the multiplier is used to that win. If it points to a benefit video game, the multiplier uses to all multipliers inside that particular benefit round.

Diving Into the Four Crazy Time Bonus Rounds

1. Coin Flip

The most basic of the 4 bonus offer rounds. A coin with a red side and a blue side is turned by a maker. Before the flip, random multipliers are assigned to both sides of the coin. Whichever side lands face up figures out the gamer's payout.

- **Benefit feature:** If multipliers are low, a "Rescue Flip" can often be activated, giving players another chance at higher rewards.

2. Money Hunt

Gamers are provided with an enormous interactive screen showing a shooting gallery with 108 random multipliers hidden behind numerous signs (like a cactus, target, or constable's badge).

- **The Gameplay:** Players utilize a virtual cannon to intend and shoot at one sign before a countdown timer expires. When the timer ends, all symbols reveal their covert multipliers, and the player is awarded the multiplier they hit.

3. Pachinko

Motivated by the traditional Japanese arcade video game, Pachinko features a big wall filled with physical pegs.

- **The Gameplay:** The live host drops a puck from the top of the wall. As the puck cascades downward, it bounces arbitrarily off the pegs before landing in one of a number of multiplier zones at the bottom. If the puck arrive at a "DOUBLE" zone, all multipliers on the board double, and the puck is dropped again.

4. Crazy Time

The supreme perk round. Gamers stroll through a red door into a surreal, virtual world including an enormous, 64-segment mega wheel.

- **The Gameplay:** The player (or the host, depending on the game version) chooses among 3 flappers (Green, Blue, or Yellow). The wheel is spun, and whatever multiplier the selected flapper points to is granted. Like Pachinko, this wheel also features "DOUBLE" and "TRIPLE" sections, allowing lucky gamers to activate astronomical wins up to the game's cap of 20,000 x.

Tips and Strategies for Playing Crazy Time

While Crazy Time is basically a video game of chance determined by a Random Number Generator (RNG) and physical physics, players frequently employ different strategies to handle their bankroll and take full advantage of home entertainment.



- **The Conservative Approach (Number Betting):**
 - Focus mainly on wagering numbers 1 and 2, that make up a big portion of the wheel. This strategy yields frequent, smaller sized wins, keeping the bankroll stable and extending playtime.
- **The Balanced Approach (Covering Bonuses):**
 - Spread small bets across all four benefit rounds while occasionally backing number 10. This guarantees eligibility for the high-paying bonus video games without draining pipes funds too rapidly.
- **The High-Volatility Approach (Bonus Hunting):**
 - Place bets specifically on the bonus rounds (Cash Hunt, Pachinko, Crazy Time, Coin Flip). This design requires perseverance and a larger bankroll, as dry spells can occur, however it offers direct access to the game's greatest prospective payments.

Best Practices for Responsible Gaming

1. **Set a Budget:** Decide on a fixed total up to invest before starting the game and never chase losses.
2. **Understand the RTP:** Keep in mind that perk bets normally have a somewhat lower RTP than basic number bets, meaning they are higher threat, higher benefit.
3. **Enjoy the Show:** Treat the betting expense as the cost of admission to an interactive game show. The main objective ought to always be entertainment.
