Understanding the Betting Layout

The Crazy Time wheel is divided into 54 sectors. Gamers can wager on numbers (1, 2, 5, or 10) or on one of the four interactive perk games. Each segment has a various frequency on the wheel, straight affecting its payment capacity and probability of landing.

- **How it works:** Inspired by the conventional Japanese arcade game, players are presented with a large physical wall filled with pegs. The host drops a puck from the top, and it bounces arbitrarily down through the pegs up until it lands in among several multiplier zones at the bottom. If the puck lands in a "DOUBLE" slot, all multipliers on the board double, and the puck is dropped again for massive prospective wins.

4. Crazy Time

- **Frequency:** 1 sector on the wheel.
- **How it works:** The supreme reward round. The host opens a red door, strolling players into a surreal, vibrantly colored virtual wonderland featuring an enormous huge wheel. Gamers should pick among three flappers (Green, Blue, or Yellow). The wheel is spun, and whatever multiplier the picked flapper indicate is awarded.
