Why Are Case Battles So Popular?

3. Diversify Your Case Selection

Prevent discarding your entire spending plan into a single high-tier case like *Operation Bravo* or *Recoil*. Rather, mix low-tier, stable-return cases with a few high-variance cases to balance the danger.

4. Make Use Of "Crazy Mode" Cautiously

Crazy Mode (where the lowest overall value wins) turns basic reasoning on its head. While it can be fun, it relies totally on hitting low-cost, low-tier drops. Do not approach this mode with standard case-opening reasoning.
